Road Work - Country Club Road and Bolton Center Road

Road Milling and paving on Country Club Road and Bolton Center Road is scheduled for the weeks of July 23rd and July 30th -weather permitting. There will be **NO PARKING** allowed on the street on these days. Expect traffic delays in this area. **Garbage** and/or recycle pickup will happen on your normal scheduled day and will NOT be delayed. *Roads are watered down when milling is done but dust may be prevalent—residents should consider temporarily covering their pools and outdoor furniture until this process has been completed.

NEWS FROM THE TAX COLLECTOR'S OFFICE 7/10/18

Tax bills were sent out the last week of June with a rate of 39 mills. They are due and payable July 1, 2018 and will need to be paid or postmarked by August 1, 2018 to avoid interest. Interest is calculated at a rate of 1 ½ % per month starting from the due date of July 1, 2018. If not paid as of August 2, 2018, 3% interest will be added to each tax bill delinquent which is good until August 31, 2018. Minimum interest charge is \$2.00 per bill.

To lookup your accounts search by last name first followed by a space and your first initial (do not use a comma). You will need to switch the first initial to everyone in the household that may have a bill due. https://www.mytaxbill.org/inet/bill/home.do?town=bolton

*a convenience fee is applied to taxes paid online

Important to note:

- Cash or check only is accepted over the counter at the Tax Collector's office.
 <u>Credit card payments are online only.</u>
- Please add your phone number to your checks in case there may be a problem with your payment.
- Please check online or call us if you are missing a tax bill. Failure to receive a tax bill does not invalidate the tax or interest charge.
- A drop slot is available to use for after hour payments. This is located to the left of the door going down to the Tax Collector's office. This use is for check payments only that are in a sealed envelope. Receipts are only sent if a self-addressed stamped envelope is enclosed. You can also print off a statement online at the link above. Please DO NOT put payments in the town mailbox.


